

Adams State University, in partnership with the Gilder Lehrman Institute of American History seeks up to 16 adjunct professors to teach online graduate courses in US history beginning in January 2017. The courses are part of the Adams State MA in Humanities with an American History Emphasis.

Adjunct professors will lead online discussion sessions, moderate discussion boards and grade written work but will not be responsible for lectures or assignments. Course lectures and assignments will be provided for each course by a lead scholar working with the Gilder Lehrman Institute. Each section is capped at 22 students.

The course topics for the Spring will be:

American Indian History

Women and Politics in 20th Century America

Amazing Grace: How Writers Helped End Slavery

Alexander Hamilton's America

Applicants may apply to teach up to three sections of one or more of these courses.
